

Region 6 Spring Assembly Report **April 17th, 2010**

I want to start by thanking you all for this wonderful service opportunity. The Assembly was very busy, yet very rewarding.

Committee Work

I was part of the Bylaws Committee and was elected as Secretary. We discussed the motions being presented at the Assembly and we drafted a new motion to be presented at the Fall Assembly.

Workshops

I attended two workshops. The Lunchtime Center Mic Workshop was about Parliamentary Procedures, and it proved to be very helpful not only for the Region Assembly but for the WSBC 2010 Business Meetings as well. The workshop "The Problem with Abstinence" was led by our Region Trustee. It was interesting, and we got great discussion summary out of it.

Business

We voted and adopted 5 motions.

1. Region 6 will now be formally represented at the World Service Business Convention.
2. The date for applying for the travel scholarship for WSBC was extended to October, so that a reminder can be voiced at the Fall Assembly.
3. Predetermined dollar amounts were removed from text regarding the disposition of unused funds.
4. Predetermined dollar amounts were eliminated for the Region Chairs Support fund, as well as opened to Regions other than 9 and 10.
5. Predetermined dollar amount was eliminated from text for the Public Information Blitz Fund.

We adopted the Region 6 Budget.

Dates for the 2011 and 2012 Spring and Fall Assemblies were voted on:

1. Spring 2011 – April 9th Fall 2011 – September 24th
2. Spring 2012 – April 21st Fall 2012 – September 29th
