These may include, but are not limited to, the following:</u> a) <u>One to three presenters will give their views followed by discussion from the floor.</u> b) <u>The participants will form small groups and each address a set of questions. After small group discussion, each group will give feedback to the workshop as a whole.</u> c) <u>A question and answer session where delegates may ask questions of a panel or trustee or delegate cochair on a specified subject.</u> <u>For all formats, a report of the workshop will be written out and included in the Final Conference Report.</u> 5) Format for discussion from the floor: Speakers will speak from the podium microphone. B	Region 6 Trustee Mary Rose Dallal <i>Contact the WSO for maker's contact information.</i>	To rescind Continuing Effects Motion 1982b and adopt a Statement on Approved Literature <u>In accordance with our Traditions, we suggest that OA groups maintain unity and honor our Traditions by selling and displaying only approved books and pamphlets at their meetings. This includes OA Conference- and board-approved literature; AA Conference-approved literature; and locally-produced OA literature. Locally produced literature must be developed according to the OA Guidelines for Locally Produced Literature, and should be used with the greatest discretion. Local literature should be considered temporary and discontinued when the OA literature approved for general use is available to cover the topic.</u>	This motion proposes adding locally produced literature to the suggested list of literature that may be displayed at meetings. The current policy lists OA Conference- and board-approved literature and AA Conference-approved literature.

This motion proposes adding AA Conference-approved literature to the existing policy. The wording is in an earlier policy. This motion proposes to add the reference for clarity on what literature is suggested for display and sale.

G	Region 4 Trustee Teresa K. <i>Contact the WSO for maker's contact information.</i>	To amend Continuing Effects Motion 1991c by deleting the paragraph and inserting: <u>The OA World Service Business Conference suggests that in all new or revised OA materials the words "compulsive eater" and "compulsive eating" be used to describe our disease in general terms, except in the personal stories of OA members.</u>	This motion proposes using only "compulsive eater" and "compulsive eating" to describe the disease in OA literature rather than using "compulsive overeater" and "compulsive overeating" other than in personal stories.
